12.04.080 - Construction and repair—Permits required—Fees—Exception.

- A. No person may construct, remove or repair any sidewalk, curb and gutter, driveway, roadway or street, or perform any other work within the public right-of-way without first obtaining a right-of-way encroachment permit. Right-of-way encroachment permit and plan review fees for work in the public right-of-way shall be based on the valuation of the work and paid in accordance with the schedule of permit fees contained in Section 15.08.030. If the work to be done in the right-of-way is in conjunction with a building permit, a separate right-of-way encroachment permit is required.
- B. Exception. None, unless waived specifically by the city engineer.
